A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO VACATING CAMINO DE LA PLAZA (RIGHT-OF-WAY VACATION NO. 1230549) – PROJECT NO. 291306.

WHEREAS, California Streets and Highways Code section 8320 *et seq.* and San Diego Municipal Code section 125.0901 *et seq.* provide a procedure for the vacation of public rights-of-way by City Council resolution; and

WHEREAS, Phillip G. Roberts, Paller-Roberts Engineering, Incorporated, acting on behalf of the owner of the underlying property, filed an application to vacate those portions of Camino de la Plaza Street and Tia Juana Street (102 feet wide) dedicated per Map 562 and Lot 179 of Map 13372, recorded on November 18, 1996, being described as Right-of-Way Vacation No. 1230549; and

WHEREAS, Right-of-Way Vacation No. 1230549 is located on property owned by Shamrock/Las Americas West, LLC, a California limited liability company; and

WHEREAS, under Charter Section 280(a)(2), this resolution is not subject to veto by the Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body, a public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the decision, and the Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to make legal findings based on the evidence presented; and

WHEREAS, the matter was set for public hearing on January 28, 2014, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that with respect to Right-of-Way Vacation No. 1230549, the Council finds that:

(a) There is no present or prospective public use for the public right-of-way, either for the facility for which it was originally acquired or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated.

The 5,125.141 square feet of vacated portions located on south side of Camino de la Plaza Street and west of Spies Lane of Camino de la Plaza Street, was originally created as part of the four lane collector street with primarily a 102 foot-wide public right-of-way. This undeveloped vacated area fronts the westerly portion of the Plaza at the Border development located at 3951 Camino de la Plaza and the existing public right of way line is irregular and does not follow the street's geometry. The proposed vacation along Camino de la Plaza Street will remove the excess right-of-way and conform with the City Standards for a uniform 10-foot parkway area while still maintaining compliance with the City's four lane collector street criteria. Therefore, there is no prospective use for this portion of public right-of-way, either for which the facility for which it was originally acquired, or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated.

(b) The public will benefit from the action through improved use of the land made available by the vacation.

The 5,125.141 square feet of vacated portions located on south side of Camino de la Plaza Street and west of Spies Lane of Camino de la Plaza Street, was originally created as part of the four lane collector street with primarily a 102 foot-wide public right-of-way. This undeveloped vacated area fronts the westerly portion of the Plaza at the Border development located at 3951 Camino de la Plaza and the existing public right of way line is irregular and

does not follow the street's geometry. The public will benefit from the vacation by relieving the City from maintaining the excess property, decrease the public liability from the undeveloped strip of property, and incorporating the area into the retail development will enhance the property's physical appearance. Therefore, the public will benefit from the action through improved use of the land made available by the vacation.

(c) The vacation does not adversely affect any applicable land use plan.

The proposed partial street vacation along the Camino de la Plaza Street will have no adverse affect on the adopted General Plan and San Ysidro Community Plan and will provide consistency to the irregular size of the public right-of-way along the length of the street.

The San Ysidro Community Plan classifies Camino de la Plaza Street as a four lane collector with recommendations to provide a sufficient buffer between the roadway and the existing riparian corridor of the Dairy Mart Ponds and to include a landscaped median or parkway where Camino de la Plaza abuts the Tijuana River levee to define a southern edge for the community. The proposed area for the street vacation is outside the riparian corridor located further north towards Dairy Mart Road. This vacation will correct an irregular public right-of-way line and would not preclude the street improvements recommended in the community plan for this segment of Camino de la Plaza.

Therefore, the vacation does not adversely affect any applicable land use plan.

(d) The public facility for which the public right-of-way was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by the vacation.

The 5,125.141 square feet of vacated portions located on south side of Camino de la Plaza Street and west of Spies Lane of Camino de la Plaza Street, was originally created as part of the four lane collector street with primarily a 102 foot-wide public right-of-way. This

undeveloped vacated area fronts the westerly portion of the Plaza at the Border development located at 3951 Camino de la Plaza and the existing public right of way line is irregular and does not follow the street's geometry. The vacation of this area will not detrimentally affect the City's public rights and facilities within the existing right-of-way. Public facilities will be retained within the remaining public right-of-way and will continue to serve the public in the same manner as originally intended. Therefore, the public facility for which the public right-of-

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that public right-of-way, as more particularly described in the legal description marked as Exhibit "A" and shown on Drawing No. 37167-1 through -4-B, marked as Exhibit "B," which are by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, is ordered vacated.

way was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by the vacation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Development Services Department shall record a certified copy of this resolution with attached exhibits, attested by the City Clerk under seal, in the Office of the County Recorder.






