A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, ACTING IN ITS CAPACITY AS THE BOARD OF THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE SILVERADO BALLROOM BUILDING PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15301 AND 15331.

WHEREAS, the Silverado Ballroom Building Project (Project) involves the rehabilitation of an historic building in the City Heights Redevelopment Project Area and will require public funding in the form of a forgivable loan; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has considered the written record for the Project and any public comments concerning the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the Project is categorically exempt

from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15301 because the Project involves alterations to

the interior of an existing structure involving negligible or no expansion of use; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the Project is categorically exempt

from CEOA under CEOA Guidelines section 15331 because the Project involves the restoration

and rehabilitation of an existing historic resource in a manner consistent with the Secretary of the

Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, acting in its capacity as the

board of the Successor Agency, as follows:

1. The Silverado Ballroom Building Project is categorically exempt from CEQA

pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 and 15331.

2. An exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2

does not apply.
