A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, ACTING IN ITS CAPACITY AS THE BOARD OF THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, DETERMINING THAT THE EL CAJON BOULEVARD PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT WITHIN THE CROSSROADS REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIROMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the El Cajon Boulevard Pedestrian Improvements Project (Project) in the Crossroads Redevelopment Project Area (Project Area) contemplates upgrades and improvements to existing streets through the repair of existing sidewalks in the Project Area; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of project which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) has considered the written record for the Project and any public comments concerning the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because the Project's contemplated upgrades and improvements to the existing streets involve only the operation, repair, maintenance or minor alteration of existing public structures and facilities and involve negligible or no expansion of the existing use; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, acting in its capacity as the board of the Successor Agency, as follows:

- 1. The El Cajon Boulevard Pedestrian Improvements Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines 15301.
- 2. An exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines 15300.2 has been determined not to apply.
