A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF WATER GROUP 787 IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO ÇEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15301 AND 15302.

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2011, the City Council of the City of San Diego [Council] approved construction involving removal and replacement of old cast iron water mains in the Mid-City areas of City Heights, Kensington-Talmadge and the Eastern communities as part of Water Group 787 on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. R-306713 [Project]; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301(c) and 15302,

and that no exception to the exemptions, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2,

applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the potential environmental effects of the

Project, and

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2014, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting and

considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project

will not have a significant effect on the environment because the Project involves negligible

repairs to existing facilities and minor alterations to the land; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council determines that the Project is categorically exempt

from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301(c)-15304 and that exceptions to the

exemptions do not apply.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council has determined that an exception to the

exemptions as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of

Exemption regarding the Project with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of

San Diego.
