A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO APPLY FOR A CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN PROGRAM GRANT AND TO ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE, AND EXPEND INITIAL FUNDS OF \$100,000 AND ANY ADDITIONAL FUNDS MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2013, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2018.

WHEREAS, the mission of the San Diego Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (SDICAC) Task Force is to provide a national network of state and local law enforcement cybercrime units; and

WHEREAS, the national ICAC program assists state and local law enforcement agencies develop an effective response to cyber enticement and child pornography cases; and

WHEREAS, this help encompasses investigative and forensic components, training and technical assistance, victim services, and community education; and

WHEREAS, due in large part to the technological aspects of these cases, the ICAC Task

Force Program promotes a multi-jurisdictional, multi-agency, team approach to investigating and

prosecuting ICAC cases, and thus makes for a safer environment for the citizens of San Diego;

and

WHEREAS, the objective of the grant program is to reduce the incidents of on-line victimization of children to include unwanted exposure to sexual material, unwanted sexual solicitations and on-line harassment; and

WHEREAS, the application has been submitted and an initial award of \$100,000 has been granted; and

WHEREAS, this action will also provide authorization to apply for and expend any additional funding made available from this grant program for the period of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is to administer the grant and is responsible for appropriate disbursement to the SDICAC; and

WHEREAS, all expenses resulting from this action are grant funded and there is no requirement for continued expenditures or services once grant funding is depleted or terminated; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his representative, for and on behalf of the City, is authorized to apply for and accept funding in the initial amount of \$100,000 for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014, Fund 600001, provided funding is secured, authorized, and made available by the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, for the purpose of implementing the ICAC Grant Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend funding in the initial amount of \$100,000 for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014, Fund 600001, provided funding is secured, authorized, and made available by the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, for the purpose of implementing the ICAC Grant Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his representative, for and on behalf of the City, is authorized to apply for and accept any additional funding made available through any amendments, extensions, or renewals of the grant for a period of up to five years from July 1, 2013 through June 20, 2018, Fund 600001, provided funding is secured, authorized, and made available by the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, for the purpose of implementing the ICAC Grant Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend any additional funding made available through any amendments, extensions, or renewals of the grant, for a period of up to five years from July 1, 2013 through June 20, 2018, Fund 600001, provided funding is secured, authorized, and made available by the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, for the purpose of implementing the ICAC Grant Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grants, if required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police is authorized to administer and operate this program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his representative, including the Chief of Police, is authorized to certify that the City of San Diego will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to this grant program.
