A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE PROCUREMENT AGREEMENT THROUGH THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO WITH IPS GROUP, INC. IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to authorize a Cooperative Procurement Agreement through the City of Sacramento between the City of San Diego and IPS Group, Inc. (IPS), to purchase single-space smart parking meters and related parts and services which also involves the installation of these meters on existing meter poles; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has determined that the requested authorization is categorically exempt from CEQA under the Existing Facilities pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 because the activity set forth in the Cooperative Procurement Agreement involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the requested authorization as well as public comment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has considered the written record and public comment for the City's request to enter into a Cooperative Procurement Agreement with IPS, and has determined that said activity is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301, and that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
