A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE BALBOA PARK "LIGHT THE PARK" PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15301, 15303 AND 15331.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the Balboa Park "Light the Park" project to improve the existing architectural lighting in major core park areas, that include replacement of existing exterior "color wash" and string lighting as well as the addition of lighting in areas not currently lit and by installing highly energy efficient LED lights, will reduce overall net energy use by more than 56 percent;

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the creation of "Light the Park" project in Balboa Park; and

WHEREAS, on 61714, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment as the project is to improve the existing architectural lighting in major core park areas;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the creation of the Balboa Park "Light the Park" project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301, 15303 and 15331.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
