A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO PURSUANT TO SECTION 147(f) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR ATMOSPHERE II.

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego (Authority) intends to issue not to exceed \$28,750,000 aggregate principal amount of multifamily housing revenue bonds, in one or more series issued from time to time, including bonds issued to refund such revenue bonds in one or more series from time to time (Bonds), in order to finance or refinance the acquisition, construction and development of a multifamily rental housing project in the City of San Diego (City) described in the notice of public hearing attached as Exhibit A hereto (Project); and

WHEREAS, in order for interest on the Bonds to be tax-exempt, section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 requires that the Bonds be approved by the City Council as the applicable elected representative after a public hearing following reasonable public notice; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing with respect to the proposed issuance of the Bonds was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City on June 5, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was held on June 24, 2014, and an opportunity was provided for interested persons to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds and on the nature and location of the Project; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego that this City Council,

as the applicable elected representative under Section 147(f) of the Code, approves the issuance

of the Bonds by the Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City does not warrant the creditworthiness of the

Bonds or guarantee, in any way, the payment of the Bonds. No moneys of the City will be

pledged or applied to the repayment of the Bonds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a Final Environmental Impact Report Consistency

Evaluation was prepared in accordance with suggested best practices outlined in State of

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Sections 15162 and 15168 on April

10, 2013, concluding that the environmental impacts of the Project were adequately addressed

and therefore, no further environmental documentation is required under CEQA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that: (i) a "Finding of No Significant Impact" was made

in August 2013 in accordance with the requirements of 24 CFR §58.71 of the National

Environmental Policy Act (NEPA); (ii) authorization for the use of grant funds was issued by the

U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on January 23, 2014; and (iii) the approval

of supplemental assistance in the form of HOME funds was categorically excluded under NEPA

on May 20, 2014, pursuant to 24 CFR §58.35(b)(7).

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**
