A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO PRELIMINARILY APPROVING THE UPDATES TO THE ASSESSMENT ENGINEER'S REPORTS SUBMITTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE CITY-MANAGED MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015.

changes that may impact the calculation of the assessment rate; reviewing the scope of services for improvements to comply with the approved assessment methodology; incorporating general benefit rates proposed for the new fiscal year; and integrating the proposed budget for the new fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, an assessment engineer has prepared such updated reports for fiscal year 2015 (i.e., the Engineer's Reports) to be considered by the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,
