A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND \$280,000 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE SAN DIEGO POLICE FOUNDATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING LAPTOP COMPUTERS FOR USE IN POLICE VEHICLES.

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Foundation (Foundation) is an independent 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization providing support for efforts that enhance police/community relations, crime prevention, and public safety through grant funding for specialized equipment, training, and cooperative community programs; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation awarded a grant to the San Diego Police Department (SDPD) in the amount of \$280,000 to purchase police officer laptops; and

WHEREAS, the SDPD has 535 patrol vehicles that require ruggedized laptops, and the laptops in the vehicles are replaced every four to five years, or when an older vehicle is retired and replaced with a new vehicle; and

WHEREAS, there are two types of laptops currently utilized by the SDPD, some mounted in the trunk of the vehicle and touch screen ruggedized laptops mounted in the front console of the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, all new vehicles ordered by the SDPD are configured for front-mounted laptops and require the new touch screen laptops; and

WHEREAS, the SDPD has ordered 67 new front-mount vehicles that will be deployed during Fiscal Year 2015; and

WHEREAS, the funds from the Police Foundation will be used to purchase replacement touch screen laptops for approximately 63 of these new vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the replacement of laptops has historically been funded by a combination of General Fund and grant fund monies; and

WHEREAS, these laptops are essential to police functions in that they provide officers mobile access to the electronic Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, electronic mapping and Automated Vehicle Location (AVL) systems, Department of Justice (DOJ) and Area Regional Justice Information System (ARJIS) databases for running inquiries and criminal histories, the Department's Criminal Records Management System (CRMS), and the Automated Field Reporting (AFR) system, which allows for the wireless submission of police reports from the field; and

WHEREAS, these new laptops will be purchased with internal 4G wireless capable modems allowing for better performance and mobility in the field; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to accept a grant from the San Diego Police Foundation in the amount of \$280,000 for the purchase of laptop computers used in patrol vehicles by police officers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend the \$280,000 in grant funds from the San Diego Police Foundation for the purpose of purchasing laptop computers used in patrol vehicles by police officers.
