A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO REAL ESTATE PURCHASE AND SALE AGREEMENT WITH BALDWIN & SONS, LLC REGARDING PROPERTY IN CHULA VISTA IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM CEQA PURSUANT TO SECTION 15312 OF THE STATE CEQA GUIDELINES.

WHEREAS, the City entered into a Real Estate Purchase and Sale Agreement, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-308334, with Baldwin & Sons, LLC, a California limited liability company, for the sale of that certain real property consisting of approximately 11.32 acres of land identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 644-313-09, located in Chula Vista, California (Property), reserving an easement on the Property for existing City water pipelines under the Property, and acquisition of access easements on that certain real property identified as Assessor's Parcel Numbers 644-310-41 and 644-311-18, and a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 644-311-17; and

WHEREAS, the First Amendment to Real Estate Purchase and Sale Agreement by and between the City and Baldwin & Sons, LLC, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 309136 (First Amendment), amends the purchase price to Three Hundred Sixty-One Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars (\$361,395), and the access easement to the City water pipelines, under the terms and conditions of the First Amendment (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects

which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15312 and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project, and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment it is the sale of surplus government property with the reservation of an easement and the acquisition of an access easement, and no physical changes to the property are contemplated by this transaction; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15312 and that an exception to the exemption does not apply.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
