A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING AND RATIFYING A SIDE LETTER AGREEMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE SAN DIEGO DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEYS ASSOCIATION REGARDING TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR FISCAL YEARS 2014 THROUGH 2018 TO IMPLEMENT THE SAN DIEGO WORKS INITIATIVE.

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2013, by San Diego Resolution R-308477 (Oct. 15, 2013), the San Diego City Council (Council) approved a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of San Diego (City) and the Deputy City Attorneys Association (DCAA) regarding terms and conditions of employment for Fiscal Years 2014 through 2018; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2014, Mayor Kevin Faulconer announced a new initiative called "San Diego Works," to challenge City employees, the City's recognized employee organizations, and City management to collaborate and submit cost-saving and operational streamlining ideas for the Fiscal Year 2016 budget; and

WHEREAS, "San Diego Works" is intended to complement competitive bidding for City services under San Diego Charter section 117(c); and

WHEREAS, "San Diego Works" will offer eligible employee teams cash awards for approved budgetary proposals; and

WHEREAS, the specific terms of "San Diego Works" are set forth in a proposed

Administrative Regulation 95.93, which the City's management team has negotiated with the

City's impacted employee organizations, including DCAA, under the Meyers-Milias-Brown Act

(MMBA); and

WHEREAS, under the MMBA, and specifically California Government Code (Government Code) section 3504, the terms of paying cash awards are a mandatory subject of bargaining; and

WHEREAS, under the MMBA, and specifically Government Code section 3505, the City, as a public agency employer, must meet and confer in good faith on proposed modifications to mandatory subjects of bargaining before a final decision on a proposed modification is made; and

WHEREAS, from July 14, 2014 until July 28, 2014, the City and its impacted employee organizations, including DCAA, met and conferred and reached agreement on the terms of "San Diego Works"; and

WHEREAS, under the MMBA and Council Policy 300-06, it is within the discretion of the Council to approve and ratify the negotiated agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to approve and ratify the Side Letter Agreement, which amends the MOU between the City and DCAA, to allow the Mayor to implement "San Diego Works"; and

WHEREAS, in the Fiscal Year 2015 Salary Ordinance, approved by the Council on April 25, 2014 (San Diego Council Ordinance O-20365), the Council stated that during Fiscal Year 2015, the Council may, upon the Mayor's recommendation, establish additional benefit programs for represented and unrepresented officers and employees by separate and specific City Council action. The Salary Ordinance further provided that, for represented employees, these additional benefit programs must be based on ratified and executed Memoranda of Understanding with recognized employee organizations, or otherwise in compliance with the MMBA and City Council Policy 300-06. For unrepresented officers or employees, these

programs must be based on other conditions of qualification that are established by the City Council in its sole discretion; and

WHEREAS, "San Diego Works" is a benefit program that will provide eligible employees with the opportunity to earn cash awards for submission and acceptance of cost-saving and operational efficiency programs; and

WHEREAS, the Council now desires to authorize the "San Diego Works" initiative on the terms set forth in the Administrative Regulation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that, pursuant to the authority of the MMBA and Council Policy 300-06, the Council of the City of San Diego approves and ratifies the Side Letter Agreement to the MOU between the City and DCAA, which amends the MOU to allow the Mayor to implement "San Diego Works," as specified in the Side Letter Agreement, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-309188.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council authorizes the Mayor or his designee to provide cash payments to eligible employees under the terms set forth in Administrative Regulation 95.93 in Fiscal Year 2015.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council delegates authority to the Mayor to negotiate any modifications to the Side Letter Agreement, which incorporates Administrative Regulation 95.93, if necessary to resolve any administrative matters that arise in implementing "San Diego Works" so long as the modifications do not have any impact on the City's approved budget, without further Council consideration, and subject to the City's compliance with the MMBA; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council directs the City Attorney to add appropriate language to the Salary Ordinance for Fiscal Year 2016 to authorize cash payments to eligible employees under the terms of Administrative Regulation 95.93 in Fiscal Year 2016.
