A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, ACTING IN ITS CAPACITY AS THE BOARD OF THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, DETERMINING THAT THE DEMOLITION OF THE FORMER VALENCIA PARK LIBRARY (101 50TH STREET) IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO EXEMPTION GUIDELINES 15301 AND 15304.

WHEREAS, the demolition of the former Valencia Park Library at 101 50th Street (Project) is proposed; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the

Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because there is a negligible or no

expansion of use in the demolition of the former Valencia Park Library and minor alteration to

land; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, acting in its capacity as the

board of the successor agency, as follows:

1. The demolition of the former Valencia Park Library at 101 50th Street is

categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 and 15304.

2. An exception to the exemptions as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2

does not apply.
