A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO PURSUANT TO SECTION 147(f) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR PACIFIC HIGHLANDS RANCH UNIT 24.

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego (Authority) intends to issue not to exceed \$19,000,000 aggregate principal amount of multifamily housing revenue bonds, in one or more series issued from time to time, including bonds issued to refund such revenue bonds in one or more series from time to time (Bonds), in order to finance or refinance the acquisition, construction and development of "Pacific Highlands Ranch Unit 24," a 96-unit multifamily rental housing project in the City of San Diego (City) described in the notice of public hearing attached as Exhibit A hereto (Project); and

WHEREAS, in order for interest on the Bonds to be tax-exempt, section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (Code) requires that the Bonds be approved by the City Council as the applicable elected representative after a public hearing following reasonable public notice; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing with respect to the proposed issuance of the Bonds was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City on September 16, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was held on September 30, 2014, and an opportunity was provided for interested persons to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds and on the nature and location of the Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego that this City Council,

as the applicable elected representative under section 147(f) of the Code, approves the issuance

of the Bonds by the Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City does not warrant the creditworthiness of the

Bonds or guarantee, in any way, the payment of the Bonds. No moneys of the City will be

pledged or applied to the repayment of the Bonds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Project is covered under the Pacific Highlands

Ranch Master EIR (No 96-7918) and a subsequent document, Findings to MEIR 96-7918 for

Units 23-28 (Project No. 5382), which environmental documents concluded that pursuant to

section 15162 of the California Environmental Quality Act, there is no change in circumstance,

additional information, or project changes to warrant additional environmental review. Further,

processing under the National Environmental Policy Act is not required as there are no federal

funds involved with this Project.
