A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT A WATER EMERGENCY DROUGHT RESPONSE LEVEL 2 - DROUGHT ALERT CONDITION PURSUANT TO SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 67.3806 IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15269(c)

WHEREAS, the State of California is experiencing one of the most severe droughts on record, prompting California Governor Jerry Brown to declare a drought emergency in California on January 17, 2014; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the City declare a Water Emergency Drought

Response Level 2 – Drought Alert Condition under San Diego Municipal Code Section 67.3806,

effective November 1, 2014 (Action); and

WHEREAS, the California State Legislature, through the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code sections 21000 through 21177, has determined that CEQA does not apply to various types of projects listed therein; and

WHEREAS, CEQA section 21084 states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15260 through 15285 list the statutory exemptions promulgated by the California State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that this Action is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15269(c); and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego City Council has considered the potential environmental effects of the Action, and

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2014, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Action as well as any public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Action will not have a significant effect on the environment as a specific action necessary to prevent or mitigate an emergency; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Action is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15269(c).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Exemption regarding the Project with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego.
