A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE TALMADGE DECORATIVE STREET LIGHT RESTORATION PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15302(d).

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego's Park and Recreation Department, Open Space Division, currently administers 50 of the 58 Maintenance Assessment Districts located throughout the City, including the Talmadge Maintenance Assessment District (District); and

WHEREAS, the District maintains certain ornamental lighting, landscape and hardscape features, and other community-wide improvements; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the District's Assessment Engineer's Report, the project to be funded by District assessments includes restoration and painting of Talmadge acorn streetlights within the District; and

WHEREAS, following a competitive selection and procurement process, the City has issued a Notice of Intent to Award a contract for the Talmadge Decorative Street Light Restoration Project, which includes restoration and painting of acorn streetlights within the District (Project); and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the proposed appropriation and expenditure of up to \$60,000 solely for the purpose of providing funds for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects

which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15302(d) and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because the activities in the District merely include restoration and painting of streetlights; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Council determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15302(d).
2. The City Council determines that an exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, does not apply.


