DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE DEC 08 2014

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO TEMPORARILY CHANGING RULE 4.2 OF THE
PERMANENT RULES OF COUNCIL RELATING TO THE
SELECTION OF THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT.

WHEREAS, Rule 9 of the Permanent Rules of Council provides that the Council President may, at any time, place on the Adoption Agenda a resolution establishing a temporary rule, that shall supersede a permanent rule for the time period as may be specified in the temporary rule; and

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2014, voters of the City of San Diego approved Proposition A which amended the San Diego Charter to change an elected officer's term of office from the "first Monday after the first day of December next succeeding their election" to the "tenth day of December"; and

WHEREAS, Rule 4.2 of the Permanent Rules of Council provides that the Council shall select a Council President "at the first regular Council meeting held after 10:00 a.m. the first Monday after the first day of December;" which this year, is December 8, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Economic Development & Intergovernmental Relations has recommended an amendment to the Permanent Rules to be consistent with the above described Charter amendment and select the Council President at the first Council meeting held on or after December 10, allowing newly elected Councilmembers to participate in the selection; and

WHEREAS, a temporary rule is necessary to allow for the Council President selection to occur after December 8; and


WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(1) this resolution is not subject to veto by the Mayor because this matter is exclusively within the purview of the City Council and not affecting the administrative service of the City under the control of the Mayor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following temporary rule shall apply and supersede Rule 4.2 of the Permanent Rules of Council until an ordinance amending Rule 4.2 is effective:

4.2 Selection of the President

At the first Council meeting held on or after the tenth day of December, the Council shall select a President from one of its members by majority vote of the Council. The President shall serve for a term of one year, commencing on the date set forth above, or until a successor is selected and qualified, whichever is later. The President may serve more than one term.
