A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER AND EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FROM THE HABITAT ACQUISITION FUND (HAF) FOR EAST ELLIOTT LAND ACQUISITION FROM WILLING SELLERS.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is the lead agency in the development of the Multiple Species Conservation Program (MSCP), having adopted the City's MSCP Subarea Plan in March 1997; and

WHEREAS, the MSCP is a comprehensive habitat conservation planning program which addresses multiple species habitat needs and the preservation of natural communities for an approximate 900 square mile area in southwestern San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, an objective of the MSCP is to conserve a connected system of biologically viable habitat lands in a manner that maximizes the protection of species and precludes the need for future listing of species as threatened or endangered; and

WHEREAS, a goal of the MSCP is to conserve biodiversity in the Multi-Habitat

Planning Area (MHPA) and to achieve certainty in the land development process for both private sector and public section land development projects; and

WHEREAS, to date, 94% of required acreage has either been conserved or obligated for future conservation. Property acquired with this action would be managed by Park and Recreation Open Space Division for the long term biological integrity of the land; and

WHEREAS, the proposed action would utilize \$1,124,771.00 from HAF to continue acquisitions of MHPA/open space property in the East Elliott area. The HAF was adopted on

February 12, 1990 (R-275129) "for acquisition, maintenance, and administrative costs associated with the establishment of biological habitat preserves"; and

WHEREAS, monies are deposited in the HAF from development projects, where the area of impact is small, and mitigation on an individual project level would be onerous and not result in significant habitat acquisitions. Monies are accrued until sufficient funds are available to acquire parcels with core biological resources and/or wildlife linkages. Use of the HAF for mitigation is allowed pursuant to the Land Development Code Section 143.0141(i)(3), and the process to use the fund is further described in the Land Development Manual Biology Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, this action will also transfer \$164,695.10 from S-00998, Del Mar Mesa Acquisition Fund to S01076, Multiple Species Conservation within Fund 400265, GFCIP Contributions. The \$164,659.10 is the remaining balance of \$2,124,000 that was appropriated (Resolutions R-290916, 295505 & 296190) for the acquisition and preservation of sensitive habitat in Del Mar Mesa; and

WHEREAS, the targeted acquisitions were completed and the remaining MHPA lands within the Del Mar Mesa area have been acquired. The remaining balance would be used towards the on-going acquisitions of MHPA lands within the East Elliott/Mission Trails Regional Park area; and

WHEREAS, this is a core MSCP biological area that provides a vital regional linkage to habitat lands to the north and south and contains coastal sage scrub, riparian woodlands, and oak forests. Additionally, WBS #S01076, Fund 200401 includes the remaining funds of \$12,670.22 from prior East Elliott acquisitions. These funds will also be used towards the current proposed acquisitions; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Chief Financial Officer or designee is authorized to appropriate and

expend an amount not to exceed \$1,124,771.00 from Fund 200401 (Habitat Acquisition Fund)

for the acquisition of property within the MHPA in the East Elliott area for conservation.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer or designee is authorized to transfer

appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$164,695.10 from \$00998, Del Mar Mesa Acquisition

to S01076 - Multiple Species Conservation within Fund 400265 GFCIP Contributions, for the

acquisition of property within the MHPA in the East Elliott area for conservation.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer or designee is authorized to appropriate and

expend an amount not to exceed \$164,695.10 from \$01076 – Multiple Species Conservation

within Fund 400265, CIP Contributions from General Fund for the acquisition of property within

the MHPA in the East Elliott area for conservation.
