A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO PURSUANT TO SECTION 147(f) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR MISSION GORGE APARTMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego (Authority) intends to issue not to exceed \$19,000,000 aggregate principal amount of multifamily housing revenue bonds (Bonds) to finance the acquisition, construction and equipping of a multifamily rental housing project in the City of San Diego (City) described in the notice of public hearing attached as Exhibit A hereto (Project); and

WHEREAS, in order for interest on the Bonds to be tax-exempt, section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 requires that the Bonds be approved by the City Council as the applicable elected representative after a public hearing following reasonable public notice; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing with respect to the proposed issuance of the Bonds was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City on November 24, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was held on December 9, 2014, and an opportunity was provided for interested persons to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds and on the nature and location of the Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego that this City Council, as the applicable elected representative under section 147(f) of the Code, approves the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City does not warrant the creditworthiness of the

Bonds or guarantee, in any way, the payment of the Bonds. No moneys of the City will be

pledged or applied to the repayment of the Bonds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proposed development activity is covered under

the Final Program Environmental Impact Report (Final EIR) for the Grantville Redevelopment

Project Area, which was certified by the City Council of the City of San Diego on May 3, 2005

and prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines.

The Planning Department conducted a Consistency Review for the project in accordance with

CEOA section 15162 in November 2014. Additionally, requirements of the adopted Final

Mitigation, Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) for the Final EIR will be applied at the

time of project review and permitting.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should HOME Investment Partnerships Program

(HOME) funds constitute a portion of the funding for the Project, a final reservation of HOME

funds shall occur only upon satisfactory completion of environmental review and receipt by the

City of a release of funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development under

24 CFR Part 58 of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). The provision of any HOME

funds to the Project will be conditioned on the City's determination to proceed with, modify or

cancel the Project based on the results of the subsequent environmental review under NEPA.
