A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO SUPPORTING THE RENEWAL AND EXPANSION OF THE NORTH SAN DIEGO COUNTY RECYCLING MARKET DEVELOPMENT ZONE.

WHEREAS, California Public Resources Code section 42010 and 14 CCR section 17914 provide for the establishment, renewal, and expansion of the Recycling Market Development Zone (RMDZ) program throughout the State to provide incentives to stimulate development of post-consumer and secondary materials markets for recyclables; and

WHEREAS, the North San Diego County RMDZ currently includes portions of the northern communities of the City of San Diego, the cities of Carlsbad, Del Mar, Escondido, Oceanside, Poway, San Marcos, Solana Beach, and Vista, and portions of the unincorporated County of San Diego, with the County of San Diego acting as the Lead Agency; and

WHEREAS, The North San Diego County RMDZ will expire on November 16, 2014, unless it is re-designated by CalRecycle; and

WHEREAS, other jurisdictions in North San Diego County, the County of San Diego, and portions of the unincorporated San Diego County wish to be included in this RMDZ, thus expanding the boundaries of the RMDZ; and

WHEREAS, the proposed expansion of the North San Diego County RMDZ includes the cities of Encinitas, Santee, and northern and eastern portions of unincorporated San Diego County that were not previously included in the RMDZ; and

WHEREAS, cities and counties must meet a 50 percent reduction in landfill waste disposal as mandated in the California Integrated Waste Management Act; and

WHEREAS, the North San Diego County RMDZ is dedicated to establishing, sustaining, and expanding recycling-based manufacturing businesses, which is essential for market development, attracting private sector recycling investments to the area, and assisting local jurisdictions in meeting the established landfill reduction goals; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego still desires existing and new recycling-based manufacturing businesses located within the region to be eligible for the technical and financial incentives associated with the RMDZ program; and

WHEREAS, the renewal and expansion of the North San Diego County RMDZ is still necessary to facilitate local and regional planning, coordination, and support of existing recycling-based manufacturing businesses, as well as attract private sector recycling business investments to the region; and

WHEREAS, the current and proposed waste management practices and conditions are favorable to the development of post-consumer and secondary waste materials markets; and

WHEREAS, the California Legislature has defined environmental justice as "the fair treatment of people of all races, cultures, and incomes with respect to the development, adoption, implementation, and enforcement of environmental laws, regulations, and policies" (Government Code section 65040.12(e)), and has directed the California Environmental Protection Agency to conduct its programs, policies, and activities that substantially affect human health or the environment in a manner that ensures the fair treatment of people of all races, cultures, and

income levels, including minority populations and low-income populations of the state (Public

Resources Code section 71110(a)); and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle has adopted a goal to continuously integrate environmental

justice into all the Board's programs and activities; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the City approves

the submittal of the application to CalRecycle to renew and expand the North San Diego County

RMDZ to include not only those areas currently in that zone but also to include the cities of

Encinitas and Santee, and northern and eastern portions of unincorporated San Diego County that

were not previously included in the zone.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the City

agrees to administer the North San Diego County RMDZ program in a manner that seeks to

ensure the fair treatment of people of all races, cultures and incomes, including but not limited to

soliciting public participation in all communities within that zone in a manner that includes

minority and low-income populations.
