A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING PAYMENT OF THE JUDGMENT IN THE MATTER OF *DE ANZA HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, ET AL*,

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) is a named defendant in the case arising from the closure of a mobile home park on Mission Bay: *De Anza Cove Homeowners Association, et al. v. City of San Diego*, San Diego Superior Court Case No. GIC 821191; and

WHEREAS, in Closed Session on September 17, 2014, the San Diego City Council, by the following votes: Yeas, Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8; Nays, None; and absent, District 9, authorize the resolution of the this litigation as to the certified class of residents of the mobile home park, said resolution is to abide by the Amended Judgment dated October 16, 2014, entered in this lawsuit with payment of attorneys' fees calculated at one third of the award plus costs as awarded by the court, for an amount consistent with the amounts set forth below; and

WHEREAS, the City will perform and make payments required by the Amended

Judgment and described in the MEMORANDUM ON TIMELINE FOR NOTICE & FUNDING

OF PARK CLOSURE, dated November 11, 2014, which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as RR
309422; and, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the Council authorizes:

1. The Mayor or his designee to pay the sum of \$32,041,657, in judgment as against the City of San Diego, for each and every claim for damages, interest, costs, and fees of any type, including attorney fees, against City of San Diego, its agents and employees, arising from

the Amended Judgment dated October 16, 2014, in *De Anza Cove Homeowners Association, et al. v. City of San Diego, et al.*, San Diego Superior Court Case No. GIC 821191.

- 2. The Chief Financial Officer to appropriate and transfer \$11,865,000 from the De Anza Operating Fund 200329 to the Public Liability Fund 720045 for the purpose of funding a portion of this action, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
- 3. The Chief Financial Officer to transfer \$18,237,158 from the Public Liability Reserve-Contingency Fund 720046 to the Public Liability Fund 720045 for the purpose of funding a portion of this action.
- 4. The Chief Financial Officer to appropriate and expend \$30,102,158 from the Public Liability Fund, Fund 720045 in Fiscal Year 2015, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
- 5. The Chief Financial Officer to appropriate and expend \$1,939,499 from the Public Liability Fund No. 720045 in Fiscal Year 2016, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
