AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 22.0101 RELATING TO THE PERMANENT RULES OF THE COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter section 14 states that the Council shall determine its own rules and order of business; and

WHEREAS, the Council has adopted the Permanent Rules of the Council (Rules) which are codified in San Diego Municipal Code section 22.0101; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the Brown Act, Council meeting agendas provide an opportunity for members of the public to address the Council on any item of interest within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Brown Act allows the Council to adopt reasonable regulations limiting the amount of time allocated for public testimony on particular issues and for each individual speaker; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to amend the Rules relating to non-agenda public comment and meeting schedules to increase efficiency and transparency; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(1), this ordinance is not subject to veto by the Mayor because this matter is exclusively within the purview of the City Council and not affecting the administrative service of the City under the control of the Mayor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 2, Article 2, Division 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended by amending section 22.0101, to read as follows:

§ 22.0101 Permanent Rules of the Council

Rule 1: TIME AND PLACE OF MEETINGS

- (c) Non-Agenda Public Comment is limited to 30 minutes during the morning session of the Tuesday Council meeting per Rule 2.2. Any remaining speakers will be given an opportunity to speak after Council concludes the other agenda items for that day.
