AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE CONSULTANT AGREEMENT WITH W.G. ZIMMERMAN ENGINEERING, INC. TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE TALBOT STREET RESTORATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2007, the City of San Diego [City] and W.G. Zimmerman Engineering, Inc. entered into a Consultant Agreement, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. C-14189 [Agreement], to provide professional engineering services for the Talbot Street Slope Restoration Project [Project]; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires a Third Amendment to the Agreement to provide necessary construction support due to unforeseen additional erosion occurring since the original design was prepared, resulting in substantial modifications to the wall in the form of additional soil nails and subsequent design required to provide the proper slope stabilization; and

WHEREAS, the Third Amendment to the Agreement with W.G. Zimmerman Engineering, Inc. will extend the total term of the Agreement beyond five years; and

WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by ordinance adopted by a two-thirds' majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute the Third Amendment to the Agreement with W.G. Zimmerman Engineering, Inc. for additional design services and

construction support for the Project, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No **60** - 20,455 in an additional amount not to exceed \$267,404 for a total contract amount of \$3,672,435, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that all funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$267,404 from CIP S-00609, Talbot Street Slope Restoration, Fund 400169, Transnet, for the purpose of executing this amendment to the agreement.

Section 3. Certifying that the information contained in Project No. 92925 has been completed in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] and State CEQA Guidelines, and that said Negative Declaration reflects the independent judgment of the City of San Diego as Lead Agency.

Section 4. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 5. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall take effect, and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
