DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE FEB 06 2015

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING TWO PROGRAM MANAGER
POSITIONS AND ONE PROGRAM COORDINATOR POSITION
FOR THE ETHICS COMMISSION FROM THE CLASSIFIED
SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on December 11, 2014, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Ethics Commission (Department) to exempt two Program Manager positions and one Program Coordinator position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the first Program Manager position will be responsible for administering and implementing the Department's audit program including audits of campaign committees and investigative audits; and

WHEREAS, the second Program Manager position will be responsible for administering and implementing the Department's investigation program including investigations into alleged violations of the City of San Diego's campaign, ethics, and lobbying laws; and

WHEREAS, the Program Coordinator position will assist with the administration of the Ethics Commission's education program, will review and analyze disclosure reports to identify potential violations of the City's campaign, ethics, and lobbying laws, and will assist with the administration and management of the Ethics Commission's operations; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter (Charter) section 117(a)(17) states that Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering department policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempt from the

Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council”; and

WHEREAS, on December 11, 2014, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the two Program Manager positions and the Program Coordinator position, as provided by the Department, the Civil Service Commission determined that the two Program Manager positions and the Program Coordinator position meet the standard set forth in Charter section 117 to be placed in the Unclassified Service; and

WHEREAS, the findings of the Civil Service Commission are set forth in a memorandum dated December 16, 2014, from Hadi Dehghani, Personnel Director, to the Honorable Council President and City Council; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117(a)(17), with the Civil Service Commission’s review and approval, the City Council now exempts from the Classified Service and declares to be in the Unclassified Service of the City two Program Manager positions and one Program Coordinator position for the Department, performing the duties set forth in the December 16, 2014, Memorandum from Personnel Director Hadi Dehghani to the Honorable Council President and City Council.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
