AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING THREE PROGRAM MANAGER POSITIONS IN THE DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2015, the City of San Diego (City)'s Civil Service

Commission reviewed a request from the Development Services Department (Department) to

exempt three Program Manager positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager in the Building Inspection section will be responsible for assisting with developing and implementing Department policies and procedures related to building codes and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager in the Land Development Review section will be responsible for assisting with developing and implementing Department policies and procedures related to the City's land development code and land use plans as well as overseeing and directing environmental and landscape review services; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager in the Transportation Review and Traffic Safety section will be responsible for assisting with developing and implementing Department policies and procedures related to engineering review and development review; and

WHEREAS, these positions are part of the Department's reorganization, and are critical to effective management and operational functions in the Department; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter (Charter) section 117(a)(17) states that the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from

the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2015, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the three Program Manager positions, as provided by the Department Director, the Civil Service Commission determined that the three Program Manager positions meet the standard set forth in Charter section 117(a)(17) to be placed in the Unclassified Service; and

WHEREAS, the determinations of the Civil Service Commission are set forth in a memorandum dated February 10, 2015, from Hadi Dehghani, Personnel Director, to the Honorable Council President and City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Council has received and reviewed a Memorandum from Personnel Director Hadi Dehghani, dated February 10, 2015, which documents that, on February 5, 2015, the City's Civil Service Commission reviewed and favorably commented on a proposal from the Department Director to exempt from the City's Classified Service three Program Manager positions in the Department. The Program Managers will be responsible for managing the Engineering, Building Inspection, and Land Development Review sections in the Department. The Program Manager in the Building Inspection section will be responsible for assisting with developing and implementing Department policies and procedures related to building codes and regulations. The Program Manager in the Land Development Review section will be responsible for assisting with developing and implementing department policies and procedures related to the City's Land Development Code and land use plans as well as overseeing and directing environmental and landscape review services. The Program Manager in the Transportation

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Review and Traffic Safety section will be responsible for assisting with developing and

implementing department policies and procedures related to engineering review and

development review.

Section 2. That pursuant to Charter section 117(a)(17), with the Civil Service

Commission's review and approval, the Council now exempts from the Classified Service and

declares to be in the Unclassified Service of the City three Program Manager positions in the

Department, performing the duties set forth in the February 5, 2015, Memorandum from

Personnel Director Hadi Dehghani to the Honorable Council President and City Council.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its

passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
