AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 18 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 22.1801; AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 24 BY RETITLING DIVISION 24 TO READ "DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT, PLANNING DEPARTMENT, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT;" AMENDING SECTION 22.2402 AND ADDING NEW SECTION 22.2403, RELATED TO THE NEW ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2013, by passage of Resolution No. R-308540, the City Council approved proposed improvements to the City's governmental operations described in Report to the City Council, No. 13-076, dated October 21, 2013 (Reorganization Report), including reestablishment of the Department of Planning, Neighborhoods, and Economic Development; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-308540 directed the Chief Operating Officer to work with the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance detailing the powers and duties of the Department of Planning, Neighborhoods, and Economic Development; and

WHEREAS, on February 12, 2014, the City Council approved Ordinance No. O-20347, which reestablished and detailed the powers and duties of the Department of Planning, Neighborhoods, and Economic Development by adding section 22.2402 in Chapter 2, Article 2, Division 24 of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to San Diego Charter section 26, the City Council may, by ordinance approved by a two-thirds vote, change, abolish, combine and rearrange the departments of the City provided for in the administrative code, which is codified in Chapter 2 of the San Diego Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the San Diego Municipal Code to reflect:
1) creation of the new Economic Development Department; 2) reallocation of certain duties and powers from the Department of Planning, Neighborhoods, and Economic Development; and 3) renaming of the Department of Planning, Neighborhoods, and Economic Development as the “Planning Department;” NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 2, Article 2, Division 18 of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended by amending section 22.1801, to read as follows:

Section 2. That Chapter 2, Article 2, Division 24 is amended by retitling Division 24 to read “Development Services Department, Planning Department, and Economic Development Department,” by amending section 22.2402 and adding new section 22.2403, to read as follows:

Chapter: 2

Article 2: Administrative Code

Division 24: Development Services Department,

Planning Department, and Economic Development Department

§22.2402 Planning Department — Powers and Duties of the Planning Director

- (a) The Planning Department is a City department. The department is responsible for long-range planning of the City’s communities and neighborhoods. The department’s responsibilities also include historic resource analysis, the multiple species conservation program, and environmental policy and analysis. An environmental section responsible for all California Environmental Quality Act policy in the City shall serve as a section of the department. The Planning Director is the administrative head of the department and shall be appointed by and may be removed by the Mayor.
- (b) The Planning Director, under the direction of the Mayor or City Manager and with policy direction of the City Council and policy guidance and

recommendations of the Planning Commission, shall be responsible for performing those duties and functions as assigned and directed by the Mayor or City Manager. Such activities, as may be assigned, shall be performed as required by federal, state and local law and regulations as may be promulgated by the Mayor or City Manager.

- (c) The environmental section of the Planning Department shall maintain that degree of independence in the performance of its functions and duties as will assure the Mayor or City Manager, the City Council, Planning Commission and the people of the City of San Diego that its review and analysis of the environmental consequences of projects under its purview, whether beneficial or detrimental, are independent and wholly objective and are not prepared for the purpose of either supporting or detracting from any project, plan or position, whether advanced by the City, any other governmental agency, a developer, a citizen or a group of citizens.

§22.2403 Economic Development Department – Powers and Duties of the Economic Development Director

- (a) The Economic Development Department is a City department. The department is responsible for the implementation of economic development programs within the City. The Department's mission is to improve the quality of life in core urban neighborhoods, create opportunities for unemployed or underemployed residents, provide community development services to those areas in greatest need, and generate new revenues to fund essential municipal services. The Economic Development Director is the administrative head of the

department and shall be appointed by and may be removed by the Mayor.


- (b) The Economic Development Director, under the direction of the Mayor or City Manager, and with policy direction from the City Council, shall be responsible for performing those duties and functions as assigned and directed by the Mayor or City Manager.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
