AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING ONE PROGRAM MANAGER POSITION IN THE OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2015, the City of San Diego (City)'s Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Office of Homeland Security (Department) to exempt one Program Manager position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager will be responsible for coordinating citywide emergency preparedness training and exercises; developing emergency protocols and procedures; developing and maintaining the City's two Emergency Operations Centers; managing and administering federal homeland security grants, and state and federal disaster cost recovery programs; and supervising risk management and threat analysis programs and procedures; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter section 117(a)(17) states that the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2015, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Manager position, as provided by the Department, the Civil Service Commission determined that the position meets the standard set forth in Charter section 117(a)(17) to be placed in the Unclassified Service; and

WHEREAS, the determinations of the Civil Service Commission are set forth in a memorandum dated June 11, 2015, from Hadi Dehghani, Personnel Director, to the Honorable Council President and Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Council has received and reviewed a memorandum from Personnel Director Hadi Dehghani, dated June 11, 2015, which documents that, on June 4, 2015, the City's Civil Service Commission reviewed and favorably commented on a proposal from the Department to exempt one Program Manager position.

Section 2. That pursuant to Charter section 117(a)(17), with the Civil Service Commission's review and approval, the Council now exempts from the Classified Service and declares to be in the Unclassified Service of the City one Program Manager position in the Department, performing the duties set forth in the June 11, 2015 memorandum from Personnel Director Hadi Dehghani to the Honorable Council President and Council, and in this ordinance.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ore	dinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day
from and after its final passage.
