AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH COLLABORATED SERVICES FOR PUBLIC INFORMATION AND OUTREACH SERVICES ON AN AS-NEEDED BASIS FOR THE WATER CONSERVATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Department is seeking an extension to the existing agreement with Collaborative Services Inc. [Agreement] through May 5, 2016 to ensure continuous availability of as-needed services to provide support to the City's "Waste No Water" drought campaign; and

WHEREAS, this support is critical to the City of San Diego's current efforts to comply with the most recent State-mandated water use reduction target of 16% by February, 2016, as promulgated by Executive Order B-29-15; and

WHEREAS, this amendment will increase the value of the existing contract by \$360,000, for a total amount not to exceed of \$1,460,000, and will extend the contract an additional six months in order to allow for the continuation of work performed by Collaborative Services Inc., through May 5, 2016, as follows; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of said City, the Third Amendment to the Agreement with Collaborative Services Inc., (Contract #4600000396), in an amount not to exceed \$360,000, bringing the total cost of the Agreement to \$1,460,000, for consulting services related to the Water Conservation Program, with a contract

expiration date of May 5, 2016, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 20545.

That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to

exceed \$360,000 from Water Utility Operating Fund 700011 for the purposes of funding the

Third Amendment to the Agreement, contingent upon adoption of the Annual Appropriation

Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the City Comptroller first

furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will

be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 2.

Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering

department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage,

a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to

the day of its passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
