DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE AUG 7 2015

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A FIFTH AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH HAYSTAX TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR AN ADDITIONAL FIVE YEAR TERM AND AN ADDITIONAL NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF TWELVE MILLION DOLLARS.

WHEREAS, on behalf of the San Diego Urban Area (SDUA) and since 2010, the City has had a contract with Haystax Technologies, Inc. (Haystax) for the provision of a Risk Management Program funded via federal Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant funds; and WHEREAS, the California Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) provided additional funding to this Risk Management Program so that it could become a statewide project; and

WHEREAS, CalOES has provided funding for the Risk Management Program through

June 2016 and will likely make funds available beyond that date; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the contract with Haystax to account for additional UASI grant monies from CalOES to spend on the statewide Risk Management Program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute a fifth amendment to the contract with Haystax Technologies, Inc. (formerly Digital Sandbox, Inc.) to extend that contract for five additional years for Risk Management Program services and support for a California statewide program.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend \$1,383,556 from Fund 600000, available via the Fiscal Year 2014 Federal Department of Homeland Security Urban Area Security Initiative grant program for the purposes of funding the

Risk Management Program tasks identified as part of the Fiscal Year 2014 Urban Area Security

Initiative grant.

Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend,

contingent upon securing future fiscal years' Federal Department of Homeland Security Urban

Area Security Initiative grant funding, an amount not to exceed twelve million dollars during the

five year extension period of the fifth amendment to the contract with Haystax Technologies,

Inc., contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying

that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its

passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day

from and after its final passage.
