AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING TO EXECUTE THE SIXTH AMENDMENT AGREEMENT WITH DOKKEN ENGINEERING FOR THE STATE ROUTE 163 AND FRIARS ROAD INTERCHANGE.

WHEREAS, the State Route 163 and Friars Road Interchange Project (Project) will provide for the modifications of State Route 163 and Friars Road Interchange in order to optimize traffic circulation within the interchange area in State Route 163 and Friars Road Interchange; and

WHEREAS, the Sixth Amendment to the Agreement with Dokken Engineering will provide for design services in the preparation of plans, specifications, and estimates for the construction of Phase 1 of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Project provides substantial benefits to traffic circulation, improving level-of-service on local streets and reducing congestion, is consistent with community planning documents and future phases of the project, improves business access within the project footprint and enhances the safety of pedestrians and bicyclists; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute a Sixth Amendment to the Agreement for design services with Dokken Engineering, Inc. for CIP S-00851, State Route 163/Friars Road, in an amount not to exceed \$668,319.00.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to

exceed \$668,319.00 from CIP S-00851, State Route 163/Friars Road, Fund 400169, TransNet for

the purposes of executing this Sixth Amendment to the Agreement.

Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering

department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a

written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to

the day of its passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
