A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO AUTHORIZE AN AGREEMENT WITH BLACK & VEATCH CORPORATION FOR PROGRAMMATIC WATER TRANSMISSION PIPELINES CONDITION ASSESSMENT (H146197)

WHEREAS, the Engineering and Program Management Division within the Public Utilities Department (Department) provides engineering services for performing and managing condition assessments of the water transmission pipelines to ensure the water system has operational reliability, thus reducing future operation, maintenance and replacement costs of the aging water conveyance system; and

WHEREAS, the performance of pipeline condition assessments requires a multi-disciplined engineering team to provide specialized expertise in various engineering disciplines associated with the implementation and execution of condition assessments, and the Department requested proposals for these services from qualified firms; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Programmatic Water Transmission Pipeline Condition
Assessment (Agreement) with Black & Veatch Corporation has a total cost value not to exceed
\$7,997,857., for a duration of five years; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute a phase funded agreement with Black & Veatch Corporation to provide Programmatic Water Transmission

Pipeline Condition Assessment services in an amount not to exceed \$7,997,857., for the duration

of five years, contingent upon adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the City Comptroller furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$7,997,857.00 from the Water Utility Operating Fund 700011, to be phase funded as follows, contingent upon adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon City Comptroller furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer:

$$FY 2015 = \$1,315,000 \text{ (Phase 1)}$$

$$FY 2017 = $2,325,000 (Phase 3)$$

TOTAL = \$7,997,857.00
