A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE AGREEMENT WITH BLACK & VEATCH CORPORATION FOR PROGRAMMATIC WATER TRANSMISSION PIPELINES CONDITION ASSESSMENT (H146197) IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15262.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to authorize a Cooperative Procurement Agreement with Black & Veatch Corporation to provide Programmatic Water Transmission Pipeline Condition Assessment Services (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$7,997,857., for the duration of five years, contingent upon adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the California State Legislature, through the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), California Public Resources Code sections 21000-21177, has determined that CEQA does not apply to various types of projects listed therein; and

WHEREAS, CEQA section 21084 states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15260-15285 list the statutory exemptions promulgated by the California State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Agreement is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15262; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on JAN 1 3 2015 , the City Council held a duly noticed public
meeting and considered the written record for the Agreement as well as any public comment; and
WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the
Agreement will not have a significant effect on the environment because it involves feasibility or
planning studies for possible future actions which the City Council has not approved, adopted, or
funded; NOW, THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED, that the Agreement is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to
CEQA Guidelines section 15262.
