## RESOLUTION NUMBER R-309466 DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JAN 30 2015

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 SLURRY SEAL GROUPS 1501 AND 1502 PROJECTS ARE CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15301(c).

WHEREAS, the Slurry Seal of Streets Groups 1501 and 1502 projects are part of the Fiscal Year 2015 Annual Street Maintenance Program, and will provide for the repair and slurry sealing of approximately 70 miles of various asphalt streets located throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Fiscal Year 2015 Slurry Seal of Streets Groups 1501 and 1502; and WHEREAS, on \_\_\_\_\_\_JAN 1 3 2015 \_\_\_\_\_\_, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment as the projects involve the resurfacing or paving of existing streets; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Slurry Seal of Streets Group 1501 and 1502 projects are categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301(c).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15301(c) does not apply.
