A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH ADS CORP. FOR SEWER FLOW MONITORING AND EVENT NOTIFICATION SERVICES IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15301 AND 15306.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego's Public Utilities Department desires to extend ADS Corp.'s services in monitoring sewage flows for the Municipal and Metropolitan Sewer Systems and thus desires to extend ADS Corp.'s agreement by a 5-year term; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.), section 21084 states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 and 15306 and that no exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 applies; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, on FEB 2 4 2015 , the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as any public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because the Project involves data collection, research, and resource evaluation activities which do not result in a serious or major disturbance to an environmental resource; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 and 15306.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
