A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYBERRY TOWNHOMES REHABILITATION PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the Mayberry Townhomes rehabilitation project (Project) involves the rehabilitation of eighteen (18) buildings containing seventy (70) residential apartments (Units) in the Southeastern San Diego Merged Redevelopment Project Area, including the rehabilitation of both the interior and exterior of the Units and related common areas, creation of a community center, office and recreational areas for use by the occupants of Units, and the reconfiguration of the Units into one (1) studio apartment, one (1) one-bedroom apartment, thirty-four (34) two-bedroom apartments, and thirty-four (34) three-bedroom apartments; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

written record for the Project and any public comments concerning the potential environmental

effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the

Project will not have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the Project is categorically exempt

from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15301 because the Project involves the repair and

minor alterations to existing structures involving negligible or no expansion of use; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

The Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines

section 15301.

2. An exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2

does not apply.
