A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ESTABLISHING A REGIONAL MARITIME VISION.

WHEREAS, San Diego's maritime origin story began with the Kumeyaay nation who relied on the ocean and bay for sustenance, and includes the Spanish explorer Juan Cabrillo who sailed here on the San Salvador, which is being commemorated with the launch of a full-scale, working replica by the San Diego Maritime Museum in April 2015; and

WHEREAS, America's Pacific orientation flourished with the gold rush and then the opening of the Panama Canal in 1914, and the Panama-California Exposition in Balboa Park in 1915 that we now celebrate 100 years later; and

WHEREAS, San Diego is home to world-renowned research institutes like Hubbs-SeaWorld Research Institute and the Scripps Institution of Oceanography; and

WHEREAS, Naval Base North Island is the birthplace of Naval Aviation, and San Diego has the largest concentration of military personnel in the world, and continues to be a strategic military port; and

WHEREAS, the "Blue Economy" can be defined as the sum of all economic activity having to do with oceans, seas, harbors, ports, and coastal zones; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Maritime Industry Report 2012 reported there are over 1,400 companies, with over 46,000 employees, producing over \$14 billion in direct sales annually in San Diego's "Blue Economy," and "Blue Tech" is the fastest growing sector with companies growing up to 35% per year and exporting up to 99% of their products; and

- 1. The City Council supports a maritime vision that recognizes and promotes San Diego as a leading global maritime technology center and supports the creation of BlueTech Incubators and related Centers of Excellence to help develop the Blue Economy.
- 2. The City Council supports the City of San Diego's collaboration with other cities in the San Diego region, the County of San Diego, the Port of San Diego, educational, for-profit and non-profit organizations to promote innovation, research, workforce development, collaboration, test bed opportunities for testing scientific theories and new technologies, and other programs of importance to companies in the regional Blue Economy.
