A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE GRANT APPLICATION SUBMITTAL FOR ENVIRONMENTAL MITIGATION LAND MANAGEMENT GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS TO THE SAN DIEGO ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS AND ALL RELATED ACTIONS FOR CITY OF SAN DIEGO PARK RANGERS AND SAN DIEGO POLICE DEPARTMENT JOINT PATROLS OF CONSERVED OPEN SPACE LANDS WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, in November 2004, the voters of San Diego County approved the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) Ordinance 04-01, which extended the TransNet 1/2 cent sales and use tax through 2048 (TransNet Extension Ordinance); and

WHEREAS, the TransNet Extension Ordinance contains provisions for the creation of an Environmental Mitigation Program (EMP), which began being funded by the TransNet Extension Ordinance on April 1, 2008; and

WHEREAS, in September 2014, the SANDAG Board of Directors approved a competitive grant process to solicit land management proposals to implement regional habitat conservation planning efforts. The SANDAG Board of Directors allocated \$1.5 million of TransNet Environmental Mitigation Program funds for Land Management Grant Program projects that promote (1) Maintenance and Enhancement of Extant Populations of Management Strategic Plan for Conserved Lands in Western San Diego County (MSP) Species and their Habitats; (2) Threat Reduction to MSP Species and their Habitats from Invasive Species and Wildfires; and (3) Habitat Maintenance, Access Control/Management and Volunteer Coordination; and

WHEREAS, the Park and Recreation Department of the City of San Diego manages approximately 25,000 acres of open space property. Park Rangers do an excellent job of maintaining the 25,000 acres, however illegal activity and severe trespassing occur and these specific "hotspot" areas need additional enforcement;

WHEREAS, the Park and Recreation Department of the City of San Diego and San Diego Police Department propose to join forces and coordinate patrols to tackle these hotspots; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego wishes to receive \$200,000 in EMP Regional Habitat Conservation grant funds, TransNet Environmental Mitigation Program funds for Land Management Grant Program projects, for 3,750 hours of overtime patrols by San Diego Police Department Officers and City of San Diego Park Rangers to decrease habitat destruction through expanded enforcement capacity at specific hotspot areas and curtail new areas of concentrated illegal activity before use patterns are established (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Project will benefit core biological areas within the Multiple Species Conservation Program's Multi-Habitat Planning Area that support sensitive species such as variegated dudleya, San Diego goldenstar, and willowy monardella; and

WHEREAS, the City understands that the EMP Regional Habitat Conservation grant funding, TransNet Environmental Mitigation Program funds for Land Management Grant Program projects, is fixed at the programmed amount, and therefore project cost increases that exceed the grant awarded will be the sole responsibility of the grantee; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his representative is authorize to make an application to SANDAG for Transnet Environmental

Mitigation Program (EMP) funds for Land Management Grant Program projects for an amount

not to exceed \$200,000 for the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if a grant award is made by SANDAG to fund the

Project, the Mayor or his delegated representative is authorized to conduct all negotiations, sign

and submit all documents, including but not limited to: applications, agreements, amendments,

and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his representative is authorized to take

all necessary actions to secure funding from SANDAG for the completion of the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if a grant award is made by SANDAG to fund the

Project, the City commits to providing \$36,000 of matching funds and/or in-kind contributions as

set forth in its grant application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized as

delegated to Financial Management to accept, appropriate and expend funds not to exceed

\$200,000 in Fund 600002 "Grant Fund – Other", if the grant funding is secured for the

completion of the Project.
