DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE APR 22 2015

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING \$16,000 TO THE TALMADGE WATCH: VOLUNTEER CITIZENS PATROL FOR ITS ANTI-GRAFFITI PROGRAM AND DUSK-TO-DAWN LIGHTING PROJECT, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with non-profit organizations and public agencies for one-time community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Talmadge Watch: Volunteer Citizens Patrol has requested funding for its patrol vehicle maintenance and operational; energy-efficient dusk to dawn lights; a paint sprayer to cover graffiti more efficiently and a more sophisticated trailer/carrier to haul paint supplies; a locked storage bin to store its equipment; night-time safety cameras which allow Talmadge Watch to record criminal behavior and share information with the Mid-City Police Department; scanners and community informational flyers so up-to-date safety information can be passed on to the community through the use of Nextdoor and use of "urgent alerts" in the case of an area-wide emergency; trailers, trash pickers, garbage bags, gloves, masks, safety vests, and dump fees; and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will be used for the Anti-Graffiti Program, Dusk-to-Dawn Lighting Project, and general volunteer patrol expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Talmadge Watch: Volunteer Citizens Patrol's request for funding for the Anti-Graffiti Program and Dusk-To-Dawn Lighting Project will benefit the public by: (1) helping to reduce crime via an increase in community awareness of safety measures and Neighborhood Watch programs; (2) an increase of clean, graffiti-free alleys and thoroughfares; (3) an increase in energy-efficient lighting in dark, unsafe areas near public thoroughfares, such as alleys, where high crime rates occur (placed on private property with owner supplying electrical work and electrical costs), but in areas benefiting public thoroughfares and/or sidewalks; and, (4) promoting community and inter-community building and cooperation with the police department and aiding the community by building clean, safe areas and stronger community ties and participation among various community groups and members; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council District 9 recommends an allocation of \$16,000 to the Talmadge Watch: Volunteer Citizens Patrol for the purposes set forth in this resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation described in this resolution is made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: "An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2015 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and the Talmadge Watch: Volunteer Citizens Patrol (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$16,000 for the project described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 309611.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$16,000 from the Community Projects, Programs, and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center 1109110009, to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreement, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.




