A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE INSTALLATION OF ANGLE PARKING ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF OREGON STREET BETWEEN UNIVERSITY AVENUE AND MADISON AVENUE IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO GUIDELINE SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the installation of angle parking has been requested along the east side of Oregon Street between: (i) El Cajon Boulevard and Howard Avenue; (ii) Lincoln Avenue and University Avenue; (iii) Madison Avenue and Monroe Avenue; and (iv) Meade Avenue and El Cajon Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of installing angle parking along the east side of Oregon Street between the limits of University Avenue and Madison Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered the written record for the project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment because there is a negligible or no expansion of use in the operation of the existing street; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The installation of angle parking along the east side of Oregon Street between the limits of University Avenue and Madison Avenue is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301.
- 2. An exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
