DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 05 2015

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXPEND \$60,770.62 IN GRANT FUNDS AND TO ADMINISTER AND OPERATE THE COPS TECHNOLOGY GRANT PROGRAM FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) is the branch of the United States Department of Justice (DOJ) responsible for advancing the practice of community policing by the nation's state, local, territory, and tribal law enforcement agencies through information and grant resources; and

WHEREAS, community policing is a philosophy that promotes organizational strategies that support the systemic use of partnerships and problem-solving techniques to proactively address the immediate conditions that give rise to public safety issues such as crime, social disorder, and fear of crime; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Resolution R-306300 (Nov. 16, 2010) (R-306300) was passed by City Council on November 9, 2010, and approved by the Mayor on November 16, 2010, authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for, accept, administer, operate, appropriate and expend a COPS Technology Program grant award in the amount of \$200,000 authorized by the DOJ COPS Office (COPS Grant Program); and

WHEREAS, these funds have been used to purchase equipment for forensic personnel in the San Diego Police Department's (Police Department) Crime Laboratory to enhance their ability to be more efficient on-scene and to provide patrol officers and detectives the resources to resolve crimes quickly and effectively; and

WHEREAS, part of these funds were also used to purchase a Liquid Handling Automated Workstation for use in preparation of blood and urine samples for alcohol analysis; however, the instrument was not capable of achieving the accuracy required for this sensitive testing and it was returned to the manufacturer and a full refund in the amount of \$57,428.52 was received from the manufacturer in October 2014; and

WHEREAS, with approval from the grantor, the refund was redirect and used to upgrade the Police Department's aging polygraph equipment, and to purchase equipment, software, and training for the newly created Forensic Technologies Unit; and

WHEREAS, along with the refunded monies of \$57,428.52, there was other grant funds not yet expended totaling \$60,770.62; and


WHEREAS, these expenditures were administered and expended subsequent to the original authority granted under Resolution R-306300, which expired on November 16, 2013; and

WHEREAS, after realizing this administrative oversight, City staff initiated a request for Council approval of the actions already implemented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOVLED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend grant funding of \$60,770.62 authorized by the COPS Grant Program for the time period from when the authority of the original resolution (R-306300) expired until grant funds are spent in full.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police is authorized to administer and operate the COPS Grant Program for the time period from when the authority of the original resolution (R-306300) expired until grant funds are spent in full.
