DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 28 2015

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND RECON ENVIRONMENTAL, INC. IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15262 FOR FEASIBILITY AND PLANNING STUDIES .

WHEREAS, the El Camino Real – Half-Mile to Via de La Valle project proposes to modify the segment of El Camino Real between Via de la Valle and San Dieguito Road in order to improve the structural integrity of the bridge over the San Dieguito River, alleviate problems associated with high flood events, improve pedestrian and vehicular access to nearby coastal and recreational resources, relieve traffic congestion, and improve consistency with the adopted land use plan for the project area; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Second Amendment to the agreement with RECON Environmental, Inc. is required to address additional reviews related to biological issues and construction sequencing, to complete the DEIR in accordance with CEQA guidelines, and to extend the contract to June 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the California State Legislature, through the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code sections 21000-21177, has determined that CEQA does not apply to various types of projects listed therein; and

WHEREAS, CEQA section 21084 states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15260-15285 list the statutory exemptions promulgated by California State Legislature; and


WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Second Amendment to the agreement between the City and RECON Environmental Inc. for environmental services for the El Camino Real-Half Mile to Via de la Valle Project;

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment as this action would secure funds for further environmental analysis and not commit the City to any future course of action; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Second Amendment to the agreement between the City and RECON Environmental Inc. for the El Camino Real – Half Mile to Via de la Valle project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15262, Feasibility and Planning Studies.


