A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM NORTH PARK REDEVELOPMENT BONDS TO CIP S-10040 NORTH PARK/MAIN STREET SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINE SECTIONS 15301(C) AND 15302(C).

WHEREAS, the North Park/Main Street Sidewalk Improvements Project (CIP S-10040) provides for sidewalk improvements that include the replacement of existing red sidewalks and decorative tile pavement (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guideline sections 15301(c) "Existing Facilities" and 15302(c) "Replacement or Reconstruction" and that no exception to the exemptions, as set forth in CEQA Guideline section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has considered the

potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered the written record for the Project as well as

public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the

Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because the sidewalk improvements

involve minor alteration of existing sidewalks, gutters, and similar facilities and are also a

replacement or reconstruction of existing facilities and structures involving negligible or no

expansion; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

The sidewalk improvements are categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to 1.

CEQA Guideline sections 15301(c) and 15302(c).

2. An exception to the exemptions as set forth in CEQA Guideline section 15300.2

does not apply.
