WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 98.0509 requires that the San Diego Housing Commission annually hold a series of public hearings to solicit public testimony on programs to be funded by the Affordable Housing Fund, and to prepare an Annual Plan for City Council consideration and approval by July 31 of each year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the Fiscal Year 2016 Affordable Housing Fund Annual Plan and determined that it appropriately addresses the housing needs of lower income residents of the City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

Housing Commission's President and CEO and General Counsel to draft amendments to San

Diego Municipal Code Chapter 9, Article 8, Division 5 (San Diego Housing Trust Fund) that

improve the operation, efficiency and administration of the Affordable Housing Fund, as directed

by the City Council, including direction provided at the public hearing held on June 9, 2015, and

reflected in Attachment 5 to the Report to the City Council CCR15-002.
