A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING THE JURISDICTIONAL RUNOFF MANAGEMENT PLAN AND SIX WATER QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PLANS.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is a co-permittee under the 2013 Municipal Storm Water Permit, San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board Order No. R9-2013-0001, as amended by R9-2015-0001 (2013 Permit); and

WHEREAS, the 2013 Permit requires the City to submit one Jurisdictional Runoff
Management Plan (JRMP) and a Water Quality Improvement Plan (WQIP) for each watershed
management area as identified in the 2013 Permit to the San Diego Regional Water Quality
Control Board by June 27, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the JRMP describes the City's day-to-day operational activities and processes to improve water quality by preventing or reducing pollution from runoff and to reduce flood risk, consistent with the requirements of the 2013 Permit; and

WHEREAS, the City is a co-permittee in six watershed management areas identified in the 2013 Permit and therefore prepared six WQIPs in collaboration with the other co-permittees in the San Dieguito River, Peñasquitos, Mission Bay, San Diego River, San Diego Bay, and Tijuana River watershed management areas; and

WHEREAS, the six WQIPs identify the highest priority water quality pollutants for each watershed management area and the corresponding numeric goals, activities, and schedules to address those pollutants between Fiscal Years 2016 and 2040, consistent with the requirements of the 2013 Permit; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the updated Jurisdictional Runoff Management Plan and associated updated Minimum Best Management Practices for Residential, Industrial, Commercial, and Municipal Sites/Sources, on file with the City Clerk at Document No. 30979, 1re adopted.
- 2. That six Water Quality Improvement Plans for the San Dieguito River, Peñasquitos, Mission Bay, San Diego River, San Diego Bay, and Tijuana River watershed management areas are adopted, and the Mayor, or his designee, is delegated authority to make updates as may be needed.
