A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DESIGNATING FAULT LINE PARK AND CORTEZ HILL PARK IN DOWNTOWN SAN DIEGO AS PARK LANDS PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 700-17.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) is scheduled to be conveyed a public park easement located at the block between Island Avenue and 14th, 15th, and J Streets in San Diego, California. The conveyance is pursuant to a redevelopment project agreement between the former Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego and Pinnacle International Development, Inc., a California corporation, as memorialized in a certain Owner Participation Agreement approved in 2005. Pursuant to that Agreement, upon completion the public park easement would be transferred to the Redevelopment Agency by the fee owner of the subject property. The park is expected to be completed in summer 2015. In anticipation of conveyance of the public park easement, the park has undergone a public planning process including being named Fault Line Park; and

WHEREAS, the City owns rights to another park area, named Cortez Hill Park (also known as Tweet Street Park), located along the north side of Date Street, between 7th and 10th Avenues, and along the east side of 10th Avenue, between Date and Beech Streets, in San Diego, California. Cortez Hill Park was opened to the public in 2008; and

WHEREAS, Council Policy 700-17 requires that all land held by the City for park and recreation purposes be either dedicated or designated as park lands. For land held in less than fee ownership, Council Policy 700-17 requires that land to be designated as park land; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that Fault Line Park, located at the block between Island Avenue and 14th, 15th, and J Streets in San Diego, California, and Cortez Hill Park, located along the north side of Date Street, between 7th and 10th Avenues, and along the east side of 10th Avenue, between Date and Beech Streets, in San Diego, California, are designated as park lands, in accordance with Council Policy 700-17.
