A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXPEND \$545,356.40 IN GRANT FUNDS AND TO ADMINISTER AND OPERATE THE INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN (ICAC) TASK FORCE GRANT PROGRAM EXTENSION FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE.

WHEREAS, the federal government has continued to make grant funds available to law enforcement through the United States Department of Justice (DOJ) for the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force Program (Program); and

WHEREAS, the ICAC Program has become an established part of the San Diego County law enforcement community and it has brought an effective combination of computer technology and investigative expertise to fight online exploitation of children; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) through the San Diego Police Department (Police Department) has participated in the ICAC Program since 2000 (San Diego Resolution R-293034 (May 1, 2000)); and

WHEREAS, the City participated in the ICAC Continuation Grant Program in 2009 (San Diego Resolution R-305284 (Oct. 14, 2009)); and

WHEREAS, Resolution R-305284 was approved on October 14, 2009, and expired on October 14, 2014, authorizing the Mayor or his designee to administer and operate the ICAC Continuation Grant Program for a period of five years, provided that funding for this purpose was made available by the DOJ; and

WHEREAS, in 2009 the City initially received \$348,774 to implement the ICAC Continuation Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, during the five-year period, more funding \$545,356.40 was made available and accepted but not expended before October 14, 2014, as authorized by R-305284; and

WHEREAS, from these additional monies, approximately \$188,000 was expended after October 14, 2014; and

WHEREAS, from these additional monies approximately \$357,000 has not been expended and the City wishes to expend the additional monies in grant funds through the grant extension period; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used for personnel, including overtime; training and travel; safety presentations; and new desktop and laptop computers for ICAC Task Force personnel; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to accept a grant extension through September 30, 2015, approved by the DOJ ICAC Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend grant funding up to \$545,356.40 which was already accepted under the authority of R-305284, from the time period from when the authority of the original Resolution, R-305284, expired, and through the grant extension period.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to administer and operate the ICAC Continuation Grant Program from the time period from when
