RESOLUTION DENYING AN APPEAL AND UPHOLDING THE ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION FOR THE VERIZON WIRELESS RIDGEWOOD PARK PROJECT (PROJECT NO. 379009).

WHEREAS, an application was submitted for a Neighborhood Use Permit and a Site Development Permit for a wireless telecommunication facility located in Ridgewood Park at 12604 La Tortola (Project); and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2015, the Environmental Analysis Section of the Development Services Department determined the project to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) and a Notice of Right to Appeal Environmental Determination was posted; and

WHEREAS, on April 28, 2015, Craig Sherman, representing Don't Cell Our Parks, filed an Environmental Determination Appeal Application (Appeal) with the City's Development Services Department stating that the environmental determination was not supported and was in error for two reasons: (1) a Notice of Exemption was filed in error because the Project was not yet approved; and (2) the Project violates Charter Section 55, which prohibits use of dedicated parkland for any use besides park and recreation purposes without approval by two-thirds of the electors of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the Appeal was heard before the City Council on June 30, 2015; and

WHERAS, a Notice of Exemption has not yet been filed for the Project and will only be

filed after Project approval; and

WHEREAS, the Project is designed and sited so as not to detract from or interfere with

Ridgewood Park or its park and recreation uses; and

WHEREAS, approval of the Project would not result in a significant effect on the

environment; and

WHEREAS, the Project is exempt under CEQA Guidelines Sections 15303; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(2) this resolution is not subject to veto by the

Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body and where a

public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the

decision and where the Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to

make legal findings based on the evidence presented; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Appeal is hereby

denied and the environmental determination is upheld.
