A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE PIPELINE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FOR USE OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY FOR A FUEL PIPELINE IN THE ROSECRANS, MIDWAY, AND MORENA AREAS OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) owns certain public right of way easements on, in, and over real property (Property) in the Rosecrans, Midway and Morena areas of San Diego, California. The City owns the Property for street and utility purposes; and

WHEREAS, the United States of America, through the Department of the Navy (Navy), is contemplating a certain pipeline project to serve federal facilities. The project would replace portions of an existing petroleum fuel pipeline located between Naval Base Point Loma and Marine Corps Air Station Miramar; and

WHEREAS, the Navy has requested allowance to relocate approximately five (5) miles of the existing pipeline into the Property. The Navy has indicated that relocation will allow better monitoring and maintenance access, and remediate encroachment issues on certain portions of the existing pipeline. The relocation plan includes removal of an above-ground portion of pipeline that runs along the La Playa Waterfront area and Bayside Trail, and would restore those waterfront areas; and

WHEREAS, City staff has negotiated a "Pipeline Installation and Maintenance Agreement" (Agreement) with the Navy, to allow relocation of the approximately five (5) miles of existing pipeline into the Property. Among other things, the Agreement grants the Navy rights to install and maintain fuel pipeline in the Property for fifty (50) years, and subjects the Navy's

use of and access to the Property to standard City conditions, requirements, and processes for

utility installation in the public right of way; and

WHEREAS, the market value of the subject real estate is \$310,000; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his

designee, is authorized and directed to execute the "Pipeline Installation and Maintenance

Agreement" on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. R-309844, with

the United States of America, for the installation and maintenance of fuel pipeline in City rights

of way in the Rosecrans, Midway, and Morena areas of San Diego, California.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his or her designee, is authorized to

execute and deliver all such agreements and all other instruments to effect and complete the

transaction contemplated by this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept

and deposit the proceeds from the "Pipeline Installation and Maintenance Agreement" into the

General Fund 100000.
