A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE AGREEMENT WITH OCEAN IMAGING, INC. IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15306 (INFORMATION COLLECTION).

WHEREAS, the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Ocean Imaging, Inc. (Ocean Imaging) for providing satellite and aerial coastal remote sensing services to maintain the City's regulatory and contractual obligations for the Point Loma and South Bay Outfall region, not to exceed \$1,166,000 for Fiscal Years 2016-2020; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (California Public Resources Code sections 21000-21177), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, section 15000, *et seq.*) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15306 and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

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WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has established that the Agreement is

categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15306 and that no

exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 applies; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential

environmental effects of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, after having considered the written record concerning the Agreement as well

as public comment, if any, the City Council has determined based upon its independent judgment

that CEQA Guidelines section 15306 covers the Agreement; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) determines

that the Agreement is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines

section 15306 (Information Collection).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council has determined that an exception

to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
