A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, SECURE, APPROPRIATE, AND EXPEND \$16,874,000 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPLEMENTING THE FY 2015 URBAN AREAS SECURITY INITIATIVE GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security identified the City of San Diego as the San Diego Urban Areas (SDUA) core city for the Federal FY 2015 Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) program, an element of the FY 2015 Homeland Security grant program; and

WHEREAS, the SDUA contains the eighteen incorporated cities in San Diego County, the unincorporated areas of the county, and related special districts; and

WHEREAS, as the core city, the City of San Diego will be the grantee and administrator of the UASI grant program for the entire SDUA; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2015 UASI program addresses the unique planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise needs of high-threat, high-density urban areas, and assists them in building enhanced and sustainable capabilities to prevent, protect against, mitigate, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism; and

WHEREAS, in May 2015 during the initial application phase, the SDUA directly applied for \$13,499,200 under the FY 2015 UASI grant; and

WHEREAS, the SDUA may also receive additional re-allocation state retention funds towards various statewide and SDUA projects, thereby potentially increasing the net FY 2015 UASI award to \$16, 874,000; and

WHEREAS, additional reallocated grant funds may increase the SDUA's FY 2015 UASI award even further; and

WHEREAS, the SDUA's five FY 2015 UASI investments address significant operational needs as defined in the SDUA's Homeland Security Strategy, and are titled as follows:

A) Enhance the Regional Risk Management and Planning Program; B) Enhance Information Analysis and Infrastructure Protection Capabilities; C) Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear, and Explosive/Weapons of Mass Destruction and all Hazards Response; D) Strengthen Communications Capabilities; and E) Strengthen Training, Exercise, and Evaluation Programs; and

WHEREAS, all funding must be allocated in support of the goals and objectives identified in the SDUA's Homeland Security Strategy; and

WHEREAS, a regional approach was taken in the development and implementation of the SDUA's Homeland Security Strategy and these FY 2015 UASI investments by involving all area jurisdictions and mutual aid partners; and

WHEREAS, while the focus of the UASI grant program is to strengthen preparedness in respect to acts of terrorism, these FY 2015 UASI investments will also enhance all-hazards preparedness throughout the region; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security provides UASI funds through the California Office of Emergency Services, which grants them to the City of San Diego to administer for the entire SDUA; and

WHEREAS, the UASI grant program enhances the City's and the region's security and public safety at no cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, there is no non-federal match or cost share required for grants under the UASI program; and

WHEREAS, these grants are reimbursable in nature, requiring the City to expend funds prior to requesting reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, the total amount to be expended is \$16,874,000, which includes potential additional state retention funds, and the total amount will be spent over multiple fiscal years; and

WHEREAS, additional reallocated grant funds may be awarded in addition to the \$16,874,000, increasing SDUA's FY 2015 UASI award even further; and

WHEREAS, expenditures will be initially sourced from fund 600000 (Grant Fund – Federal), and then reimbursed from the Federal FY 2015 UASI grant program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to apply for, accept, and take all necessary actions to secure \$16,874,000 in grant funds, and any additional grant funding awarded under this program, from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the purpose of implementing the FY 2015 Urban Areas Security Initiative grant program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend the \$16,874,000 in grant funds, and any additional grant funding

awarded under the FY 2015 Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) grant program, as well as execute all agreements necessary for the purpose of implementing the FY 2015 Urban Areas Security Initiatives grant program, contingent upon funding being secured.
